## **Action Taken Report on Teachers Feedback (Academic Performance)**

Based on the report of analysis, following actions have been taken by the institution:

**Action taken:** The overall academic performance of the institution was opted 'excellent' by 50% students, while 29 % marked 'very good'. Thus, teaching and non-teaching were asked to fulfill the lacuna.

#### M. Pharm Sem I and Sem II

#### 1. Overall understanding of the subject

**Action taken:** The overall understanding of the subject was indicated 'excellent' by QA department students, while 'excellent', 'very good' and 'good' by students of the pharmaceutics department. Additionally, to enhance understanding of the subject, teachers used videos, ppts and animations.

## 2. Applicability/relevance to real life situations

**Action taken:** Students of both departments indicated 'excellent', 'very good' and 'good' for 'Applicability/relevance to real life situations'. Here, teachers correlated theoretical concepts by simulating with simple examples to real life situations.

#### B. Pharm Sem I and Sem II

## 1. Overall understanding of the subject

**Action taken:** Students marked 'excellent', 'very good', 'good' 'satisfactory' for 'overall understanding of the subject'. Theoretical subjects are made easy to understand by teaching the subject in simple language and by supporting with models and charts.

## 2. Applicability/relevance to real life situations

**Action taken:** Students indicated 'excellent', 'very good', 'good' and 'satisfactory' for the above point. Teachers correlated topics with daily life and explained the applicability with real life situations so as to get life-long learnings.

## 3. Theoretical concepts of syllabus supported by Practical/Experiments

**Action taken:** Teachers made efforts to correlate theoretical concepts of syllabus by practical, which resulted in feedback as 'excellent', 'very good' and 'good'. Furthermore, teachers made theoretical concepts interesting by showing them videos and animations.

**Action taken:** The 'excellent', 'very good' and 'good' feedback assured that the subject instilled creativity in the students. However, efforts are taken to instill creativity by use of models, videos, animations by the subject teachers.

#### B. Pharm Sem III and Sem IV

## 1. Overall understanding of the subject

**Action taken:** Students marked 'excellent' for both semesters, and also 'very good' and 'good' which confirmed overall understanding of the subject. However, some theoretical subjects such as physical pharmaceutics and pharmaceutical organic chemistry are made easy to understand by teaching the subject in simple language and supported by practical experiments.

## 2. Applicability/relevance to real life situations

**Action taken:** Here, to relate the subject with real life situations, teachers used daily life examples correlating to theoretical concepts and made the topic easy. Students marked 'excellent', 'very good' and 'good' for the question 'Applicability/relevance to real life situations'.

## 3. Theoretical concepts of syllabus supported by Practical/Experiments

**Action taken:** Students marked 'very good' and 'good' 'satisfactory' for 'Theoretical concepts of syllabus supported by Practical/Experiments'. Practicals are made interesting by combining them hand-in-hand with theoretical concepts as well as by the use of sophisticated instruments and showing them videos and animations.

## 4. Study material availability is adequate

**Action taken:** Students marked 'excellent', 'very good' and 'good' as students are having access to libraries rich in reference and textbooks, e-books, e-material, videos links, use of Google classroom and uploaded teaching material on MOODLE.

#### B. Pharm Sem V and Sem VI

Teachers used daily life examples correlating to theoretical concepts and simulated the subject relevant to real life situations. Teachers attended Faculty Development program, seminars and webinars to update and disseminate that knowledge to students.

## 5. Does the subject instills creativity

**Action taken:** Teachers took effort to make the subject interesting by showing videos, animations, models and charts, which resulted in 'excellent', 'very good' and 'good' responses to the question 'Does the subject instill creativity'.

## Action taken Report on Teachers' Feedback 2022-23

## 1: Depth of course contents

Action taken: Teachers allotted to courses of B. Pharm semester I to VIII, M. Pharm semester I and II indicated 'excellent' and 'very good'. Depth of course content is good. However, some topics which are considered as 'must be included' in the syllabus are taught by teachers as 'content beyond syllabus'.

#### 2: Recent advances in course are covered/Not

**Action Taken:** Semester I, II, III and IV courses such as HAP I & II, POC I, Biochemistry, pathophysiology, physical pharmaceutics, instrumental methods of analysis which are basic and core subjects did not have recent advances. However, teachers provided extra information considering the recent advancements in these courses.

## **3:** Applicability/relevance to real life situations

**Action Taken:** Teachers of B. Pharm semester I, III, V, VII and M. Pharm semester-I marked Very Good and Good because some core courses such as pharmaceutical analysis, pharmaceutical organic chemistry, medicinal chemistry, instrumental method of analysis were not related to real life situations.

#### 4: Does the course instills creativity

Action Taken: Institute follows the curriculum designed by SPPU, wherein, institute does not have authority to make changes. However, to fulfill this gap, the institute conducted various competitions that helped to encourage and create interest amongst students such as poster presentations, participation in National Pharmacy Week, various NSS activities where students show-case their ideas and creativity. Students were motivated to participate in various competitions at national and international forums to inculcate creativity and innovative ideas to them. Students created you —tube videos which really showed their innovativeness towards performing experiments.

#### 5: Does the course address about human/social values, professional ethics

**Action Taken:** Basic and core subjects such as computer applications, pharmaceutical organic chemistry and medicinal chemistry did not inculcate human/social values, professional ethics. However, the institute addressed human/social values by forming an anti-ragging committee chaired by senior faculty of the institute which is composed of both faculty and student

representatives to avoid any undue incidences of ragging either in the institute. Thus, human values are inculcated in students. Students participated at various National Service Scheme (NSS) activities to support the society, which creates awareness and instills human and social values. Institute organized 'Yoga and Meditation' to cope with stress. Students attended various seminars and webinars to adapt to normal life after the stressful COVID 19 pandemic. Institute organized 'World Pharmacist Day', conducted an 'Ad-Mad competition' and arranged a rally and street play on 'Tuberculosis Awareness' to spread the awareness of different government schemes for TB patients. Apart from all these activities, through value added certificate courses professional development of students is carried out as follows: Certificate courses 'Pharmacovigilance' 'Clinical Research' and 'Personality and Soft Skill Development' inculcate professional ethics such as thinking ability, group discussions, creativity, innovation, personality and soft skills, teamwork, leadership, administration, time management, communication skills and interview skills, dynamic personality and with a good set of attitude and transferable and life skills to meet the global standards, skills needed for entrepreneurship.
