













MINUTES OF 16TH MEETING OF INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL

5. To consider the submission of NAAC-AQAR for the year 2019-20.

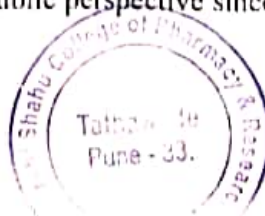



The resolution was passed unanimously.


