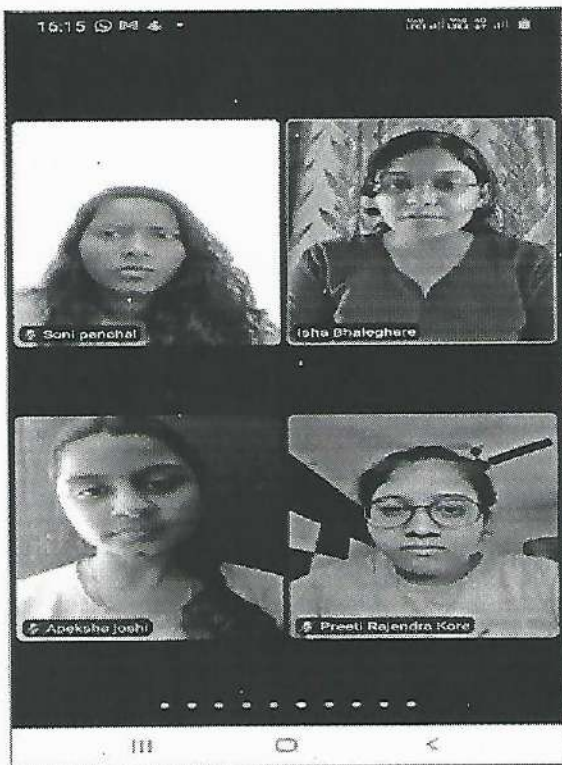

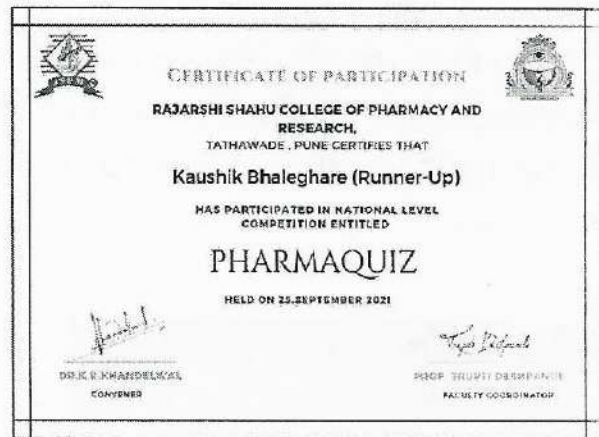

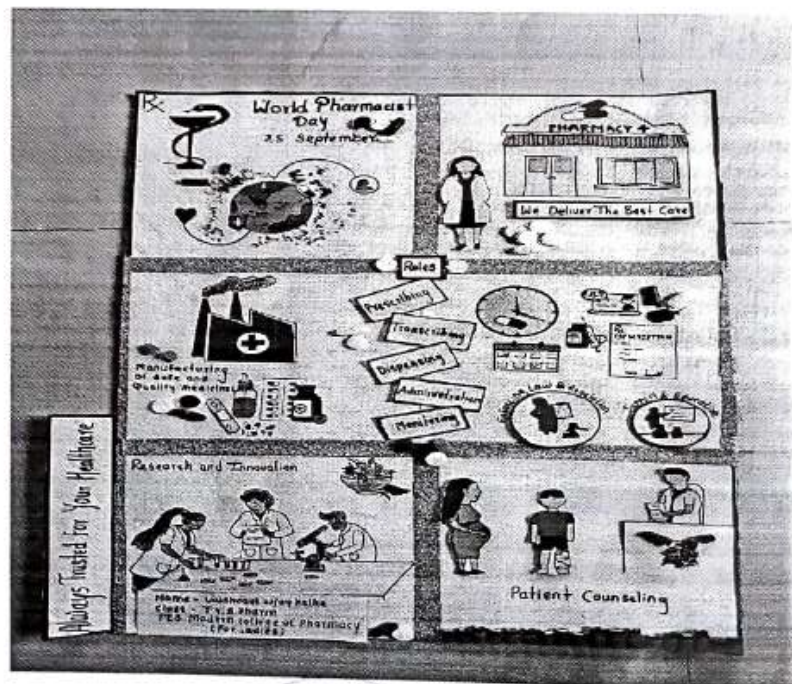
WORLD PHARMACIST DAY CELEBRATION 2021



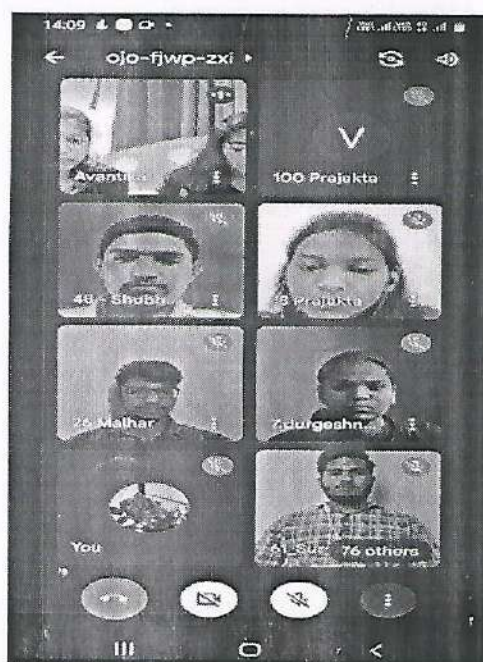



Minority welfare Day

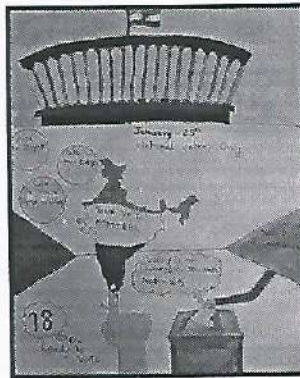
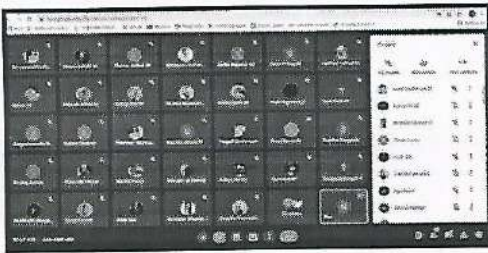
NSS Activity: Youth Day Celebration


The day was celebrated on the birth anniversary of **Swami Vivekananda** to inspire the younger generation to come up with innovative ideas and plans to make India a developed nation.




NSS Activity: Gender sensitization awareness workshop
